Building on the success of the numerous **Space Generation Advisory Council (SGAC)** events around the world especially in Asia-Pacific, the **SG[ASEAN]** is a two-day workshop focused in enhancing the understanding of students and young professionals in space in Thailand.

Happening on **August 24rd-25th 2019**, the event would witness at least **40 delegates** (aged 18-35 years) from around the world and numerous guests from space agencies, embassy space attaches, and space industry representatives. SG[ASEAN] features panel discussions, keynote speeches, and intensive working group discussions on the following topics: (1) Capacity building for the ASEAN space sector, (2) Space for society, (3) Space policy, transparency and safe practices, and (4) Space collaboration among ASEAN countries.

The event also highlights its side event, an **industry speed mentoring session**, happening on the day prior to the event to allow the delegates to engage with today's space industry leaders.

Structure

Speed Mentoring Event

- The event is on August 23rd from 5:00 PM to 8:30 PM (registration starts from 4:00 PM)
- Approximately **20 mentors** will each give **2-3 minute presentations** about their company and background (total 1 hour)
- Delegates will have **eight 15-minute sessions** to meet with eight mentors (total 2 hours).

Panels

- There will be **two (2) panels** focused on (1) the ASEAN regional space sector and (2) international space policies and regulations. Each panel will feature **four panelists** who gave **10-minute speeches** prior to the panel. The panel will be moderated by the keynote speaker.
- The panel will be 40-minutes long with **10 minutes** of public **Q&A sessions**.

Technical Presentations

- There will be **eight (8) technical presentations**. Each presentation will be **10 minutes** long.

Keynote Speeches

- There will be **four (4) keynote speakers**. Each Keynote presentation will be **20 minutes** long.
