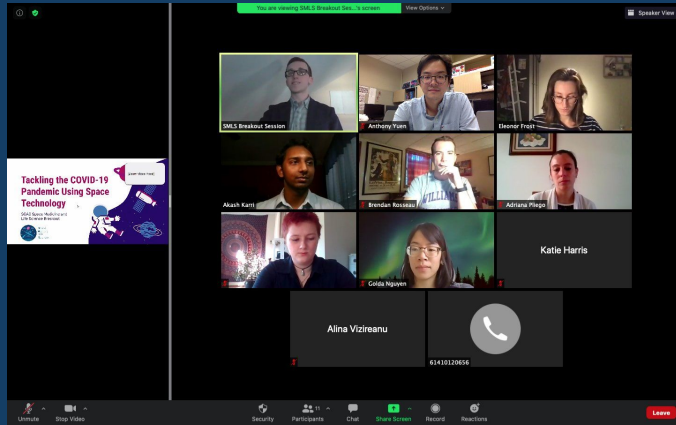
Our Impact on the Global Space Industry

SGAC has also started to work closely with the **National Space Council Users' Advisory Group** to represent the views and interests of students and young professionals in the space industry.

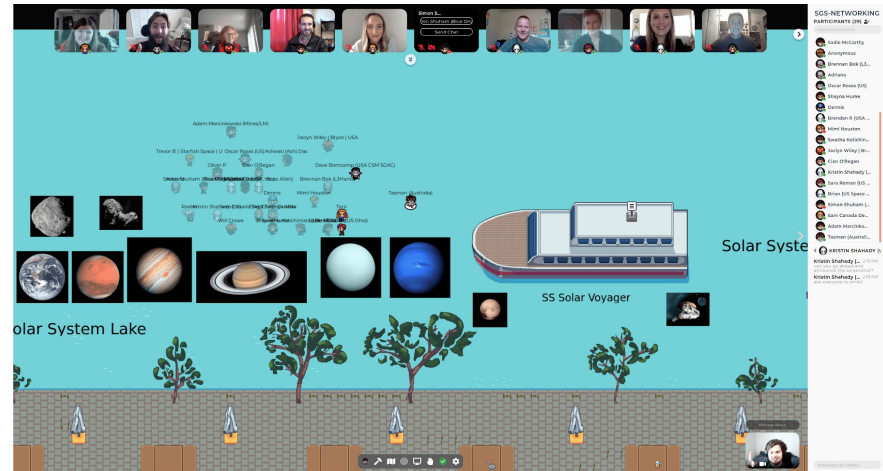

How you can be a part of SGFF2021...

Level	Sponsored Event	Amount	Benefits
 Sun	Lunch Keynote	\$20,000	1-hour keynote address with Q+A from delegates during lunch. Includes branding on badges, bags, and notebooks. Also includes Panel Participation. Keynote and panel will be streamed to virtual delegates.
 Saturn	Dedicated Networking Session	\$15,000	30 minute organization introduction then 2 hour dedicated networking session with delegates and organization.
 Neptune	Keynote	\$5,000	45 minute keynote address with Q+A from delegates. Keynote will be streamed to virtual delegates.
 Mars	Breakout Session	\$3,000	Guided discussions with delegate group, moderated by an organization representative over two days. Discussions can be either in-person OR virtual. Introductions to organization are given to the entire delegation virtually prior to the event.
 Earth	Scholarship	\$2,500	Funds travel, lodging, SGFF registration for one delegate based on organization's selection criteria. Can adjust for various expenses.
 Mercury	Ice Breaker Networking Session	\$1,500	Organization will give a 5 minute presentation followed by 1 hour of 'speed' networking with delegates, then by 1 hour of lunch with delegates in freeform format. Multiple sponsors will participate.
 Moon	Coffee Break	\$1,500	Short introduction with organization representation during coffee break to network with delegates. Includes table to display promotional materials.
 Kuiper	Panel Participation	\$1,000	Short introduction as a speaker or moderator for a panel. Typically 1-hour sessions including 15 minutes of Q+A. Panel will be streamed to virtual delegates.
